ST' JOHNS CHURCH, NOTTING HILL

St John's Church is in Lansdowne Crescent just off Ladbroke Grove at its highest point. The 50m steeple is a prominent landmark, visible throughout Notting Hill and parts of Kensington.

There is ample parking nearby, but watch for the restrictions and the rules governing residents' parking zones.

The church is accessible on foot from local Underground services. Holland Park (Central Line Zone 2) is our nearest station, but Notting Hill Gate Zone 1 is 6 minutes from the church, and is served by Central, District and Circle Lines.
